« Arts sur Glace » is a non lucrative organisation. It was founded in April 2008 with the mission to foster the development of skating as a new performance art. Since its creation, the organisation supported various artistic initiatives on ice and gives lessons of artistic skating performance.

The Festival gives the opportunity to all kind of skaters to showcase creations in a context leaving space for their originality. Participants are encouraged to present numbers originating from a personal idea. The event is not competitive. No ranking will be established. Special laureates will be given along with participation prizes for skaters and the public. The festival will be held from 20h00 to 22h00. It will include spectacular performances from « Le Patin Libre » troop.

Recruiters from « Le Patin Libre » will attend the event. Who knows? This festival could become a door to exciting opportunities...

Rules

Everything is allowed, everything is possible, but a few rules exist to protect the harmony of the festival.

- Participants promise to behave as proper artists respecting the integrity of others. An inappropriate conduct will cause an exclusion from the festival.
- The Festival can welcome a limited number of participants. First arrived, first served. A priority will be given to numbers which couldn't be presented within traditional figure skating tests or competitions.
- Participants will have to arrive at Camilien-Houde Arena at 19h00, on the event's night.
- The participants who won't have signed the disclaimer on the registration form or the « Team's Annex » (see registration form), won't be allowed to skate during the event.
